Thank you for downloading the Vectorworks Viewer, a free resource from Vectorworks, Inc. that allows you to easily view and print Vectorworks drawings.

The Vectorworks Viewer enables Vectorworks designers to share models and drawings with you and other clients and colleagues who may not have a copy of the Vectorworks software. Because files cannot be changed or saved, designers can distribute their documents with confidence, knowing that their work is protected.

The Vectorworks Viewer allows you to:

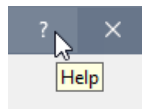
- Use the **Pan** tool to move the drawing around the drawing window, changing the area of display
- Use the **Zoom** tool to magnify portions of the drawing area
- Use the **Tape Measure** and **Protractor** tools to measure drawing objects
- Use the **View** menu commands to change the **Standard Views**, **Projection**, and other drawing views
- Use the tools in the **3D Tools** tool set to simulate movement over, around, and through models

Because Vectorworks drawings are protected, the Vectorworks Viewer does not allow you to:

- Draw or create objects
- Edit files
- Save files
